A major programme of masterclasses that will run until next March, 2010 was unveiled earlier this month. Organised by Applied Arts Ulster, *masterclasses* is a yearly programme of visits by internationally recognised designer-makers of ceramics, silver + jewellery to Northern Ireland for 2 days.
